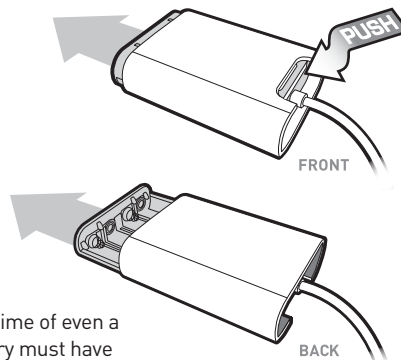

Quick Start Guide

Thank you for purchasing TuneJuice, the backup battery that works on all iPod models with Dock Connector. Setup is simple, and you will have power whenever you need it.

Getting Started

1. Press the Griffin logo button on TuneJuice's bottom edge. Slide open the battery tray and insert four AAA batteries into TuneJuice. Four are included in this package to get you started, but you can use any four AAA batteries.
2. Plug TuneJuice into your iPod.



Performance

TuneJuice will dramatically increase the available play time of even a partially charged iPod. However, the iPod internal battery must have **some** charge; an iPod with a completely discharged internal battery will not be able to make use of TuneJuice's battery backup capability.

TuneJuice performance will vary depending on your iPod's battery charge.

With a fully charged iPod and new batteries:

- a. TuneJuice adds up to 2 hours of video play.
- b. TuneJuice adds up to 14 hours of audio play.

With a partially charged iPod:

- a. TuneJuice adds up to 1 ½ hours of video play.
- b. TuneJuice adds up to 10 hours of audio play.
